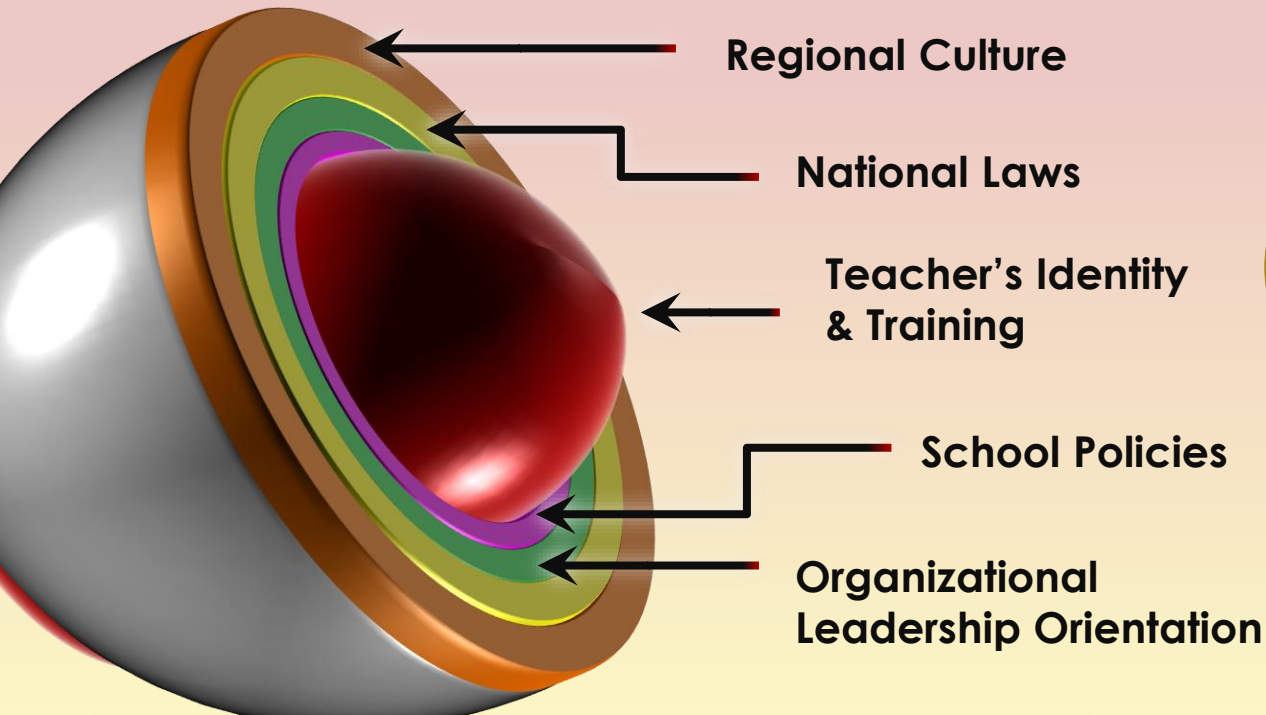


Culture Shock!

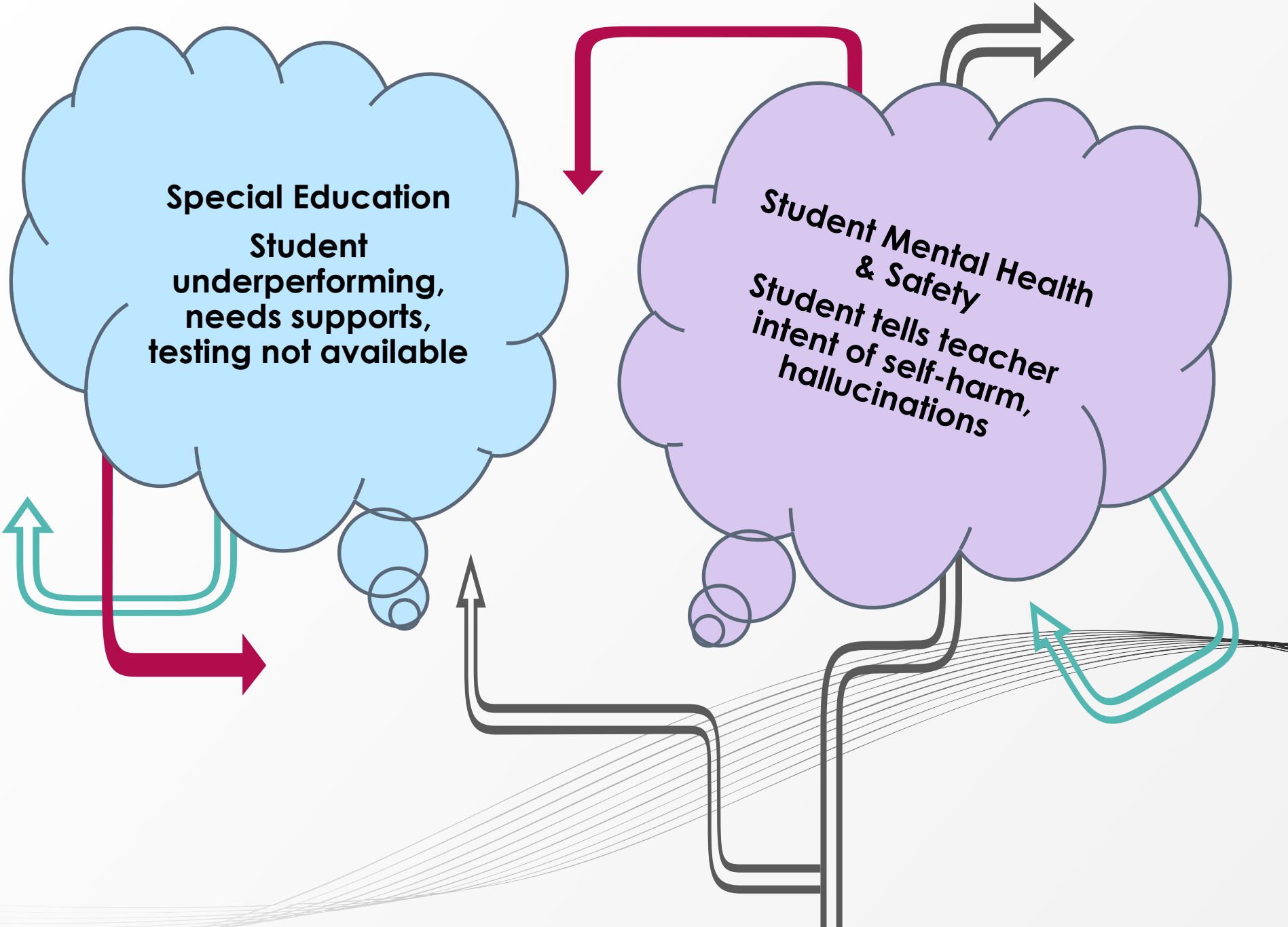


Acculturative Stress (Berry, 2006)
